## Dr Rob Marshall's Breeding Programme for Gouldian Finches

## - and other finches & canaries

This Breeding Programme provides breeding pairs with their best opportunity to produce and rear strong young. The effects of the programme are rapid. It maximises fertility and creates strong babies from day one so that the young produced remain healthy throughout the critical developmental stages of their life.

Day of Week	Water Supplements	Food Supplements	Additional information
Monday	Fresh if water ph <7	Turbobooster, Quik-gel E Powder & Fvite	Quik gel is given each second day in drinking water or soft food mix.
Tuesday	S76 once a month	Turbobooster, E Powder & Fvite	Airsac Mite Treatment controls airsac mites and protect breeding pairs and their young from other stress induced diseases. S76 - 5mls/2 litres of drinking water for one day each month.
Wednesday	Fresh if water ph <7	Turbobooster, Quik-gel E Powder & Fvite	
Thursday	Megamix <sup>2</sup> if water ph >7	Turbobooster, E Powder & Fvite	<sup>2</sup> Megamix is used daily when drinking water ph >7 to control thrush and e.coli infections.
Friday	KD <sup>1</sup>	Turbobooster, Quik-gel E Powder & Fvite	<sup>1</sup> KD 1/4 teaspoon/litre of drinking water helps maintain normal foregut pH and counteract stress.
Saturday	Dufoplus³/ loford⁴ Megamix	Turbobooster, E Powder & Fvite	<sup>3</sup> Dufoplus (2.5ml), loford - (5ml) and Megamix (2mls) are mixed into one litre of drinking water. Although Turbobooser. Dufoplus and loford contain loads of vitamin D, still try to provide your birds with as much sunlight as possible.
Sunday	loford/Megamix	Turbobooster, Quik-gel E Powder & Fvite

The Food Supplements are best given in Alan Simpson's highly successful soft food recipe (see overleaf) or they may be mixed into dry seed. The soft food is very easy to make and guarantees your birds receive the best nutrition possible. Breeding outcomes will be dramatically improved with a minimum of fuss. For continuing good health this feeding system is best combined with Dufoplus/loford (vitamins ADE & trace elements lodine, iron), water cleansers (KD & Megamix to adjust ph levels) and regular S76 treatments to control airsac mite infections.
